

THE GREEN DEAL DATA SPACE


- will interconnect currently fragmented and dispersed data from various ecosystems, both for/from the private and public sectors.
- will offer an interoperable, trusted IT environment, for data processing
- will provide a set of rules of legislative, administrative and contractual nature that determine the rights of access to and processing of the data.

- Technical Blueprint
 - Digital ecosystem, soft infrastructure (agreements and logical building blocks)
 - Re-use, integration of existing initiatives, platforms, tools at European level
 - Interoperability architecture
 - Lessons learned from the European contribution to GEOSS (community standards+mediators, APIs)
 - Security & trust architecture
- European initiatives are part of the design
 - Research infrastructures (EPOS)
 - Community infrastructures (EMODNET)
 - GEO Flagships (GOS4M)
 - Copernicus Services, DestinE, ...
- GDDS vs. GEO/GEOSS
 - Focus on data sharing and trust, vs. focus on knowledge generation (Earth Intelligence)
 - GDDS focus on governance
 - Focus on European Green Deal vs. focus on engagement priorities
